Day 1

Day 2

Post-lunch, students join a real British classroom to observe and absorb authentic learning styles. The afternoon ends with co-curricular activities alongside Clayesmore boarders, followed by dinner and an exciting boarding activity. (Could be a movie night, marshmallow evening, or karaoke! Surprise guaranteed.)



Day 3

Tuesday, 30th September – Continue the Momentum

A full repeat of Day 2's enriching schedule, intellectual stimulation, class room observation, cultural blending through activities, and another memorable boarding event to wrap up the day.



Day 4

Wednesday, 1st October – Culture Meets Coastline

Morning sessions continue as before until lunch. In the afternoon, the group heads out to explore Iwrene town and its coastline - Designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site due to its outstanding geology.



Day 5

Thursday, 2nd October – Reflections & Recognition

It's presentation day! Students showcase their group projects in the morning and enjoy a relaxed lunch. The afternoon is free for some downtime before the evening's special event: a Mini Graduation Ceremony celebrating their achievements and growth. Time to pack, reflect, and sleep early for the next big adventure.

An early departure takes students to Oxford University for a walking tour of its historic colleges and courtyards. The journey continues to Lord's Cricket Ground or Chelsea FC Stadium. Dinner at an Indian restaurant adds a comforting touch of home as we check in to our rooms in London.
