Day 1

Sunday, 28th September – Touchdown & Tranquility

Day 2

Monday, 29th September – Specialization focused session

After an 8 AM breakfast, students dive into their first Specialization focused session (8:30–11:00 AM). A short break will refresh the group before classes resume from 11:30 AM–1:00 PM. Post-lunch, students join a real British classroom to observe and absorb authentic learning styles. The afternoon ends with co-curricular activities alongside Saint Felix boarders, followed by dinner and an exciting boarding activity. (Could be a movie night, marshmallow evening, or karaoke! Surprise guaranteed.)



Day 3

Tuesday, 30th September – Continue the Momentum

A full repeat of Monday's enriching schedule—intellectual stimulation, classroom observation, cultural blending through activities, and another memorable boarding event to wrap up the day.



Day 4

Wednesday, 1st October – Culture Meets Coastline

Morning sessions continue as before until lunch. In the afternoon, the group heads out to explore Southwold town and its iconic beach – a quintessential English seaside experience featuring beach huts, a pier, and the fresh sea breeze.



Day 5

Thursday, 2nd October – Reflections & Recognition

It's presentation day! Students showcase their group projects in the morning and enjoy a relaxed lunch. The afternoon is free for some downtime before the evening's special event: a Mini Graduation Ceremony celebrating their achievements and growth. Time to pack, reflect, and sleep early for the next big adventure.





Day 6

Friday, 3rd October – Academia Meets Adventure

An early departure takes students to Cambridge University for a walking tour of its historic colleges and courtyards. The journey continues to Lord's Cricket Ground or Chelsea FC Stadium, followed by the drive to the London hostel and check-in. Dinner at an Indian restaurant adds a comforting touch.



Day 7

Saturday, 4th October – Capital Calling

It's time for London! Students will enjoy the capital's iconic sights via a Hop-On Hop-Off Bus Tour and River Thames Cruise. Expect to see Buckingham Palace, Tower Bridge, Big Ben, and more—snapping selfies and soaking in centuries of British history.
