Day 1

Arrive London → St. Felix (Southwold)

Heathrow arrival (PM), coach to St. Felix School. Campus tour, room allocation, welcome dinner, program briefing.



Day 2

St. Felix: Settle + Specialization

AM: Specialization block (choose: Public Speaking, STEM Lab, Leadership, UK Culture & Etiquette).

Midday: Classroom observation.

PM: Co-curriculars with St. Felix students (sports/drama/music). Evening community mixer.




Day 3

St. Felix: Build & Apply

AM: Specialization workshop + mini-project briefs.

PM: Project work + reflection circle. Light seaside walk after dinner (weather-permitting).

Day 4

Suffolk Coast Local Sightseeing

AM: Short classes.

PM: Southwold Pier & beach photo walk; optional stop in Aldeburgh for high street and coastline. Back for dinner and dorm activity.




Day 5

St. Felix: Project Prep

AM: Project work.

PM: Co-curricular activities and boarding event. Pack for London. Early night.





Day 6

Transfer to London + British Museum

Coach to London, hotel check-in. **British Museum** highlights tour. Early evening in **Covent Garden** (street performances, dinner). London orientation briefing.



Day 7

London In-Depth (Royal & Westminster core)

Guided Westminster walk: Buckingham Palace, St James's Park, Horse Guards, Downing Street, Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey exteriors.

Thames viewpoint time. Optional London Eye (group decision). Dinner near South Bank.





Day 8

London In-Depth (City & South Bank) + Theatre

AM: City of London walk: St. Paul's exterior, Millennium Bridge, Tate Modern exterior, Shakespeare's Globe exterior.

PM: **Hop-on hop-off loop** for broader coverage (Tower Bridge/Tower of London exteriors).

Night: **West End theatre show.**



Day 9

Oxford University Day Trip

Rail/coach to **Oxford**. Guided college precinct walk (Radcliffe Camera, Bodleian exteriors, classic quads). Time for souvenirs on the High Street. Continue to Shebbear. Campus tour, dorm allocation, welcome with boarding team.





Day 10

Shebbear: Specialization & Classroom

AM: Chosen specialization (progression module).

PM: Classroom observation in live lessons. Co-curricular with Shebbear boarders (outdoor games, art, music). Evening quiz/-karaoke.



Day 11

Shebbear: Project Sprint

AM: Workshop + group project build (UK-theme capstone).

PM: Mentor check-ins, reflection logs. Hot chocolate & Camping (weather-permitting).



Day 12

North Devon Local Sightseeing

Half-day **North Devon** explore: options include **Clovelly** village lanes, **Bideford** quay, or coastal walk near **Westward Ho!** Back to campus for sports.



Day 13

Shebbear: Rehearse & Refine

AM: Finalize capstone.

PM: Dress rehearsal. Evening house activity with local students; write thank-you notes to hosts.



Day 14

Capstone Showcase + Graduation at Shebbear

AM: Capstone presentations to faculty.

PM: **Graduation Ceremony at Shebbear College** with awards and group photos. Celebration dinner. Pack for departure.

Coach to Heathrow. Fly home.

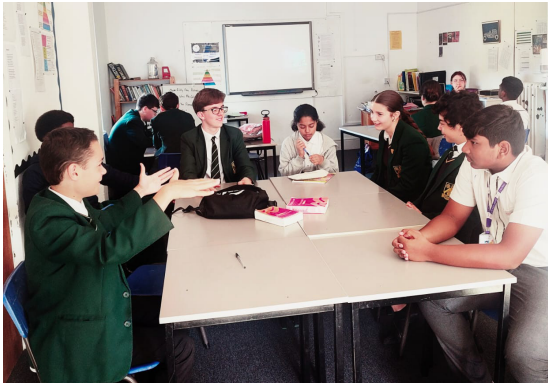
