Day 1

Arrive London → Shebbear (Devon)

Heathrow arrival (PM), coach to Shebbear College. Campus tour, room allocation, welcome dinner, program briefing.



Day 2

Shebbear: Settle + Specialization

AM: Specialization block (Public Speaking, STEM Lab, Leadership, UK Culture & Etiquette).

Midday: Classroom observation.

PM: Co-curriculars with Shebbear boarders. Evening community mixer.



Day 3

Shebbear: Build & Apply

AM: Specialization workshop + mini-project briefs.

PM: Project work + reflection circle. Low-key games night.



Day 4

North Devon Local Sightseeing

AM: Short classes.

PM: Clovelly village lanes / Bideford quay / coastal walk near Westward Ho! (as per weather). Back for dinner and dorm activity.



Day 5

Shebbear: Project Prep + Activity Night

AM: Project work.

PM: Boarding event (certificates, photos). Pack for transfer.





Day 6

Transfer to Clayesmore (via countryside stop)

Coach to Clayesmore School, Dorset. Scenic stop en route (market town viewpoint). Check-in, campus tour, welcome.



Day 7

Dorset Local Sightseeing

Half-day Dorset explore: Shaftesbury's Gold Hill, Corfe Castle village, or Jurassic Coast section (Lulworth/Durdle Door). Back to campus.



Day 8

Clayesmore: Specialization & Classroom

AM: Progression module in chosen specialization.

PM: Classroom observation with local faculty. Co-curriculars with Clayesmore students.





Day 9

Clayesmore: Project Sprint

AM: Workshop + capstone build.

PM: Mentor sessions, reflection logs. Bonfire/hot chocolate (weather-permitting).



Day 10

Clayesmore: Rehearse & Refine

AM: Finalize capstone.

PM: Dress rehearsal. Evening house activity.



Day 11

Showcase + Clayesmore Certificates

AM: Capstone presentations to faculty.

PM: Clayesmore participation certificates, celebration dinner. Pack for London.



Day 12

Transfer to London + British Museum

Coach to London, hotel check-in. British Museum highlights tour. Evening in Covent Garden.



Day 13

London In-Depth (Royal & Westminster core)

Guided Westminster walk: Buckingham Palace, St James's Park, Horse Guards, Downing Street, Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey exteriors.

Thames viewpoint time. Optional London Eye. Dinner near South Bank.





Day 14

London In-Depth (City & South Bank) + Theatre

AM: City of London walk: St Paul's exterior, Millennium Bridge, Tate Modern exterior, Shakespeare's Globe exterior.

PM: Hop-on hop-off loop (Tower Bridge/Tower of London exteriors).

Night: West End theatre show.
